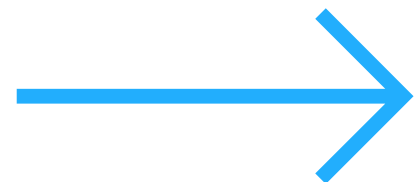
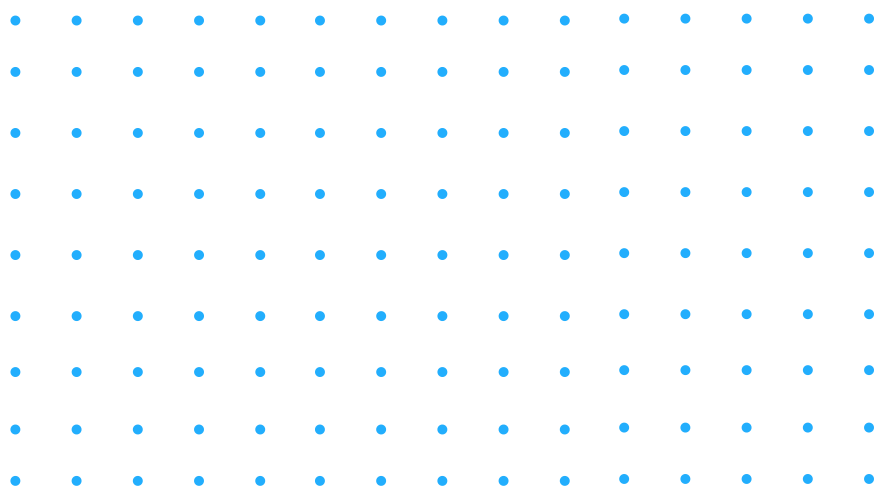




# You're still tracking waste in spreadsheets

**If your waste data lives in Excel, you're making decisions with yesterday's numbers — at best.**

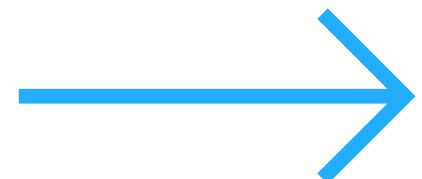
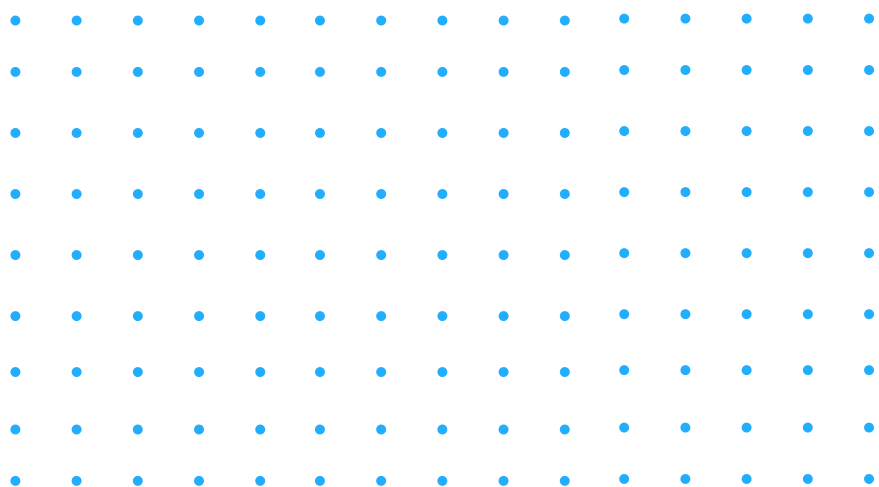




# Your vendors set the price — and you just pay it

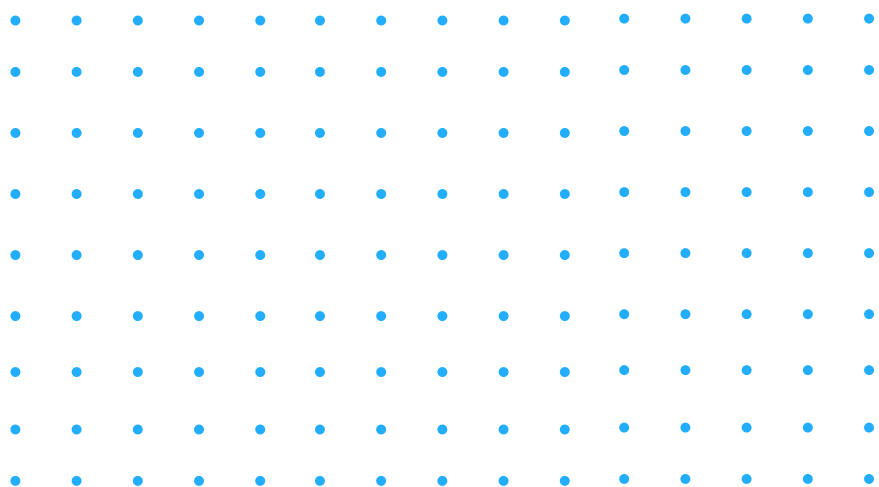




# Paper manifests are eating your compliance budget

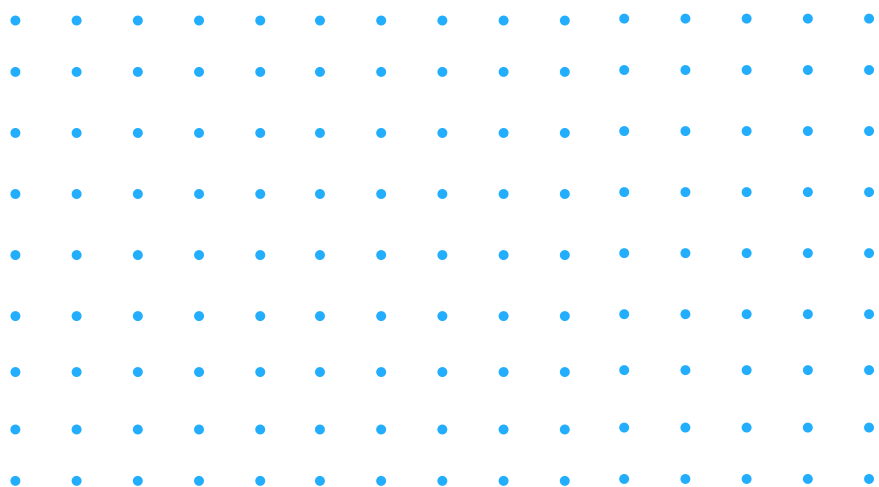




# Nobody owns your waste program

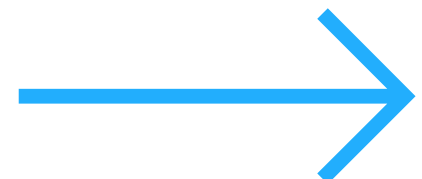
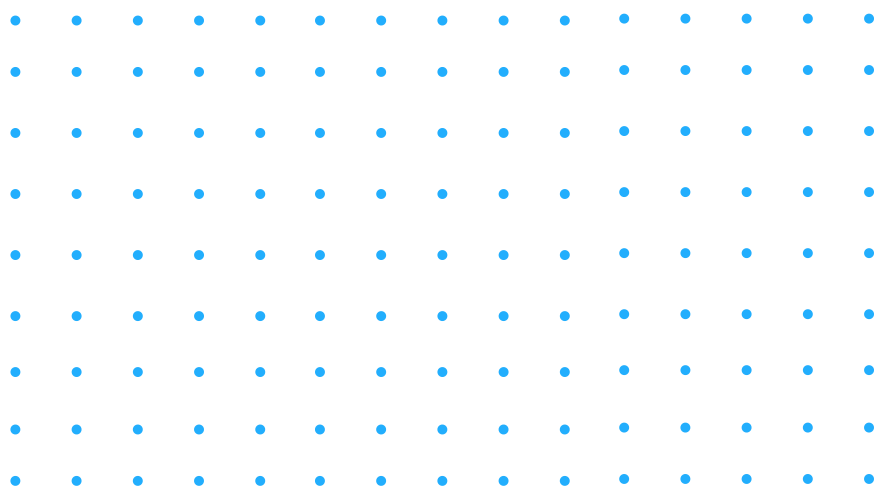
